 You need <u>field trip days</u> during your 4 semesters --> participate as early as possible

What you may not forget

- Check the bulletin boards in the main entrance hall <u>frequently</u> for short-term information regarding courses, dates etc...
- You will get study information from Alexandra Wicke on a regular basis by email --> make sure that she has your up-to-date email address
- University email account (also valid for ILIAS-login) http://www.rz.uni-freiburg.de → myAccount User ID and initial password are sent to newly enrolled students by email to the deposited mail address and in addition along with the "UniCard" by post. You get access to
 - Online course schedules, registration confirmation and exam registration (HISinOne) through the University's administration
 - E-learning platform ILIAS
 - Access to the University Library → activate your UniCard via MyAccount → User profile → Unicard → activate
 - Freiburg University Library's as well as Baden-Württemberg Library's Online literature databases (ReDI)
 - Use of the main computer work-stations (e.g. University IT Services and University Library)
 - o Internet access through VPN/WLAN
 - o Freiburg University email accounts
 - o Personal Storage Space
- You need to <u>register for all module examinations</u> (written exams, <u>reports</u>, <u>seminars</u>, <u>field trips...</u>).

Usual registration periods:

Winter term October 1st - February 1st Summer term April 1st - July 1st

Please watch out for special announcements.

Within these periods you may also resign from a registration. Outside these periods no (de)registration is possible. In case you are sick on an exam day you have to hand in a sickness certificate from your doctor within three working days to the examination office (see address above). Be careful: it is not sufficient to post it within three days - it has to be there!

Students enrolled at the University of Freiburg must register for each new semester during the registration periods: Winter Semester: June 1st to August 15th Summer Semester: January 15th to February 15th. In order to register for the semester, you must transfer the student fees. If you have not completed your registration by the end of a semester, you will be exmatriculated automatically.
